

CERTIFIED NURSING ASSISTANT JOB DESCRIPTION

EDUCATION:

High School graduate or equivalent. Training as a Nurse Aide as required by State Regulations with a certificate of completion and a NC Listing on the Health Care Personnel Registry. Current CPR Certification and valid NC Driver's License.

EXPERIENCE:

One year of previous experience in home care desired. Experience which demonstrates maturity, reliability, and ability to function independently under supervision of a Registered Nurse. Ability to competently demonstrate Aide skills.

ACCOUNTABILITY:

The In-Home Aide – Certified reports to the Patient Care Coordinator and the Registered Nurse Supervisor.

FUNCTIONS:

The In-Home Aide – Certified functions as a team member of First Choice Home Care, Inc. This individual provides competent, confidential, quality care and assistance with activities of daily living (ADLs), personal care, and other home-based services to clients living in their own homes according to NC State regulations, and follows a written plan of care prepared by a Registered Nurse, and documents the care provided appropriately.

Responsibilities include but are not limited to the following:

- 1. Conducts self in an appropriate manner according to the agency code of ethics.
- 2. Understands Patients' Rights and Responsibilities.
- 3. Knowledge of Child/Adult Abuse and Neglect, and procedure for reporting.
- 4. Knowledge of and compliance with Agency Policies and Procedures.
- 5. Complies with agency dress code, projecting a positive image of FCHC, Inc. in the community.
- 6. Follows Universal Precautions, Infection Control procedures, and HIPAA laws.
- 7. Explains procedures to client and encourages client in self-help as appropriate.
- 8. Identifies physical, emotional, and developmental patient needs or changes, and informs nurse and/or supervisor.
- 9. Follows the plan of care, providing assistance with ADLs including all aspects of mobility, bathing, dressing, eating, toileting and other personal care tasks.
- 10. Provides for the patient's privacy and confidentiality.
- 11. Uses proper body mechanics for the safety of the client as well as prevention of injury to self.
- 12. Performs Range of Motion (ROM) exercises as indicated.

- 13. Measures and records intake and output.
- 14. Takes and records TPR and BP.
- 15. Prepares simple meals following dietary instructions.
- 16. Informs supervisor promptly of any unexpected or unusual changes in the patient's condition, behavior, environment, or family situation.
- 17. Safeguards equipment and supplies, and client's personal property.
- 18. Uses specialized equipment only after demonstrating competency.
- 16. Maintains clean and safe environment by competently performing housekeeping tasks.
- 17. Demonstrates courteous, cooperative, respectful behavior.
- 19. Documents all pertinent information appropriately.
- 20. Does not administer but assists client with medications.
- 21. Knows and carries out emergency procedures.
- 22. Responsible for performing tasks that are within the scope of his/her educational preparation and knowledge, permitted by the policies and procedures of the agency and federal, state and local laws and regulations.
- 23. The Nurse Aide may not perform any duties or procedures which require the skill or education of a licensed nurse.
- 22. Completes minimum of 12 hours continuing education per year.
- 24. May perform CNA I x 4 skills for a client only after receiving thorough instruction by a nurse and demonstrating competency to a nurse. Those 4 CNA skills are determined by the Agency with authorization from the Board of Nursing.

OTHER QUALIFICATIONS:

- 1. Able to stand, bend, stoop, squat, kneel and reach freely.
- 2. Able to freely lift up to a maximum of 50 pounds.
- 3. Able to assist client with standing, walking, sitting, and turning in bed.
- 4. Able to read and interpret instructions related to the care of the client.
- 5. Able to assess the patient using the 5 senses.
- 6. Reliable transportation.
- 7. No facial piercings, or excessive or offensive tattoos.
- 8. Men will be cleanly shaven or facial hair neatly trimmed.

EVALUATIONS:

Performance evaluations are done by the Patient Care Coordinator with input from the Registered Nurse Supervisor.
